Joseph Moore was a master mariner who migrated from England to Australia in 1820 and set up a shipping business. He and his sons owned Moore's Wharf. In 1835 Captain Moore was granted 40 acres of land on the upper reaches of Sirius Cove. Captain Moore's colourful life will be reviewed and compared with his better known contemporaries Archibald Mosman and Robert Towns.
