This talk is about Mosman's roads from the 1830s until the present: their routes, naming, funding, construction and maintenance. It also considers the provision of land for roads, drainage, street lighting, pedestrian crossings, divided roads, and the shortest and longest roads.

John Dansie was a registered surveyor with the Department of Main Roads and the Roads and Traffic Authority in New South Wales for 40 years. He is a longstanding Mosman Historical Society committee member and was the 2014 Mosman Citizen of the Year.
