John will discuss the background to the unique 1900 public competition in Australia that resulted in the present national flag of stars and crosses. He will describe that flag's significance and purpose and also show a variety of other historically important Australian flags to demonstrate the rationale behind them.

John Vaughan, a vexillographer, is Australia's leading authority on the design, etiquette, protocol and history of flags. His designs include the Scottish-Australian flag recently flown from the tower of Scots Kirk in Mosman and the flags for Lord Howe Island, Willoughby City and Greater Sydney.
